Our aim is to promote the diversity of textile art practices.

The exhibition theme "Make the Ordinary Extraordinary" challenges textile artists from around the world to collaborate with each other or artists from other disciplines.

Timeline:

March 30, 2020 - Call for Entries - Online applications open for Expression of Interest (EOI)/payment of Entry Fee

Sept 1, 2020 - Close of EOI and payment of Entry Fee

April 30, 2021 - Submission Form and images of completed work to be submitted online

(A Dropbox link "Request for Files" will be sent to Entrants on receipt of payment)

August 11, 2021 - Online Gallery Exhibition Opening (to remain available online until March 2022)

Conditions of Entry

Entry Requirements

Entries must be a collaboration of two or more artists, one of the collaborators must be a textile artist.

Expression of Interest and entry payment must be submitted online and received before midnight Sep 30, 2020

Submitted works must have a demonstrable textile element and be the artists/s original design and creation.

The artist warrants that the entry and any materials submitted are original, are the property of the artist/s and do not infringe any third-party rights.

Artists may submit up to three (3) collaborative works. There is a separate payment for each work.

Each work must have been executed in the 12 months prior to the exhibition and not shown in any other exhibition or online prior to submission and the Opening of the Exhibition.

Entries may be shown as "For Sale" in the virtual exhibition. No commission will be collected for any sale of artworks.

Global Textile Hub will not be involved in the sale, other than to provide a catalogue listing of prices.

Any Sales would be finalised directly between the Purchaser and Artist.

Artwork Requirements

Artwork form: Each artwork submitted can be 2D as one piece or multiple pieces that relate as one (e.g. Diptych) or 3D – as one piece, or as a collection of pieces that relate as one work.

Artwork Dimensions - there is no size limitation.

Artists are encouraged to use natural fibres and treatments where possible or found or stashed materials ... reflecting the "ordinary" theme.

Entry fee shall be AU\$50 for each art work submitted. Payment will be made through PayPal/either account or credit card. To help you make your online payment click **HERE** and view the short "How to" video.

Each Artwork will be accepted only as a high resolution image with completed submission form and previous payment of the entry fee. A separate Submission Form is required for each artwork.

Size of Images: Images should be at least 3000 pixels on the longest side - minimum resolution 180 dpi.

A short Artist Statement of no more than 100 words is required to be submitted for each work.

A short description of the creative process of no more than 75 words shall be submitted for each artwork and shall provide detail of the Title, Dimensions, Medium's used, Year made, Retail Price, if for sale.

There will be no charge for delivery of artwork or insurance cost - as works will be submitted only as images.
